Please correct the item/items within the next 30 days of this notice to avoid any further investigation or pursuing of correction of the violations.

Inadequate maintenance of lawn to include overgrown grass, shrubs or trees, and visibility of excessive leaves on lawn
Inadequate maintenance of home, fence, pool, or other visible structures on the property (outside perimeter in need of paint/repair, roof repairs, damages from squirrels/pests). Removal of mold/algae from house. This reportedly can impose possible health risks when exposed to some individuals
Improper Storage of Trash and/or Unwanted Items on the front, side or behind the property
Parking Violation (Parking of vehicles in the front yard, unfenced backyard, and/or beside the residence, on the street over-night. Expired or no tags on vehicles and flat tires
Storage of boats, trailers, and operating/non-operating vehicles on the street, front, side and/or behind unfenced property
Failure to cleaning up behind your pet and/or allowing them to release themselves on neighbor's property
Improper Control of pet(s); walking pets without a lease (to include cats) Pets not properly confined. Early morning (before 6 a.m.) or late-night dog barking
Improper Supervision of Children
Violation of Community's Speed Limits
Violation of NTHA/City/County Noise Ordinances
Mosquito Breeding Sites (long-standing dirty water in containers, pool)
